

Mass

Even though the Quince ceremony is not a sacrament, it is usually celebrated with a Catholic mass.

Most important requirements you **MUST** consider:



1. Anticipated time to reserve the church and availability of the priest

At least six months before the desired Quinceañera date. Also, suggest your proposed date for your celebration and inquire if the Priest would be willing to prepare you throughout the process.

2. Active parish members

Many churches require Quinceañera to be baptized and reached their First Communion. You'll be expected to submit the sacramental certificates. Must attend mass and participate in the services.

3. Preparatory class

It is common for parishes to require that you be a member of that church and that you take preparatory classes, similar to first communion courses. Ask if any fees are applicable for the mass.

4. Fee for the church

Once your desired date is available you'll be expected to pay a non-refundable fee in

order to reserve the church. An average of \$400 is required to be paid half will be required to reserve the church. Also, you are responsible for reserving the musician/choir and for the fee this implies.

5. Decoration

Decoration restrictions varies with each church. However, the family is required to position for two large flower arrangements to decorate the sanctuary. Flowers are always welcome! All will remain at the church afterwards.
